Our program outreach at Nalanda, Patna, Supaul, Purnea, Gaya districts (Bihar) and Sahebganj, Pakur, Ranchi districts (Jharkhand). Organization has reached up to 28543 ultra poor households at 97 blocks in Bihar and Jharkhand. It is one more step towards making the underprivileged section of society self reliant. The organization continuously emphasizing, focusing and working on global development issues. It's initiatives is towards making community and govt. sensitive and responsible towards the well being of poorest of the poor and vulnerable group.



ABHIYAN is dedicated to establish a self reliant society where love, truth, philanthropic ideology and humanity has of high importance through minimizing existing social evils i.e. caste system, touch ability ,religious feeling, dowry, child marriage, child labour, child trafficking, human trafficking etc. With the enlighten past of our Bihar and Jharkhand and by following the ideology of Gandhi, Vinobha and Lok Nayak Jaiprakash Narayan the organization has continuous efforts towards developing self power at society through community mobilization, awareness, labour contribution, developing community based organization, awareness building on govt. schemes and programs. The Organization is also taking initiatives for conducive social change through implementing women empowerment, strengthening youth, children, adolescent girls, sustainable agriculture, village development and innovation programs. The organization is making awareness on constitutional rights and responsibilities, human rights, also making legal awareness among community people to minimize existing corruption. We further emphasize to develop new strengthened Bihar and Jharkhand through environment conservation, conservation of natural water, land, forest animals and practice of natural technologies by mass mobilizing and community sensitization. The organization has implemented different community need based and culturally viable programs i.e. promotion and strengthening of women based organization (SHGs), community health and nutrition, mother and child health, consumer rights, environment conservation, youth skill development, disabled empowerment, kitchen garden, livelihood activities, panchayat empowerment, right to information, arsenic awareness programs, cultural program on different issues, MGNREGA etc. with the support of govt. and non govt. agencies, as a result there is favorable output in the area of education, health, community awareness, livelihood promotion, women empowerment, youth skill, reproductive and child health, disable rights

In the mean time I express my gratitude to the team members of ABHIYAN, community resource persons, volunteers, local governance and line departments whose cooperation and functional participation helped the organization to reach the set objectives and to the generosity of all the donors in providing funds to implement our interventions. #### The Origin

Inspired by Gandhi Jee, Vinoba Bhave, Lohia and Lok Nayak Jai Prakash Narayan a group of people with improved social devotion and feeling organized themselves and formed a voluntary Organization with the aim "To establish a just Society in which no one remains hungry, unemployed, illiterate and exploited." ABHIYAN came into existence on the eve of International Women's Day in 1991 and was registered under the Societies Registration Act, of 21, 1860.

The prime focus of the Organization is convergence with govt. schemes and program, making govt. sensitive, education and training, upliftment of the status of ultrapoor. It also emphasises on proper implementation of govt. schemes and programs and COVID-19 awareness and vaccination. With the ideology of equality, making effort in bringing deprived section of society to mainstream through organising and education. We have strong faith on equal participation from downtrodden people with improved social feeling.

#### Objective:-

- (a) Campaigning against poverty, inequality, exploitation, injustice and ignorance.
- (b) Empowerment of the rural villagers through formation and strengthening of Self-help groups, livelihood promotion and encouraging scientific agricultural practices.
- (c) To create awareness and organize rural poor towards their rights, entitlement, duties and responsibilities by providing information and sensitization.
- (d) To mainstream disadvantage and challenged children with education and ensure reach of benefits and rights.
- (e) To improve water, sanitation and health status at rural villages through convergence with concerned govt. department and community awareness
- (f) Improving health and reproductive health status of mother, children and adolescent girls at the rural villages.
- (g) To strengthen local self-governance particularly to elected women representatives through sensitizing capacity building, improving decision making ability and developing leadership skill.
- (h) Rehabilitation of persons with disabilities in the communities and convergence with govt. schemes and programs.
- (i) Socio-economic and cultural empowerment of rural poor women.
- (j) Rehabilitation, capacity building for preparedness and support to flood victims.
- (k) Community sensitization towards environment conservation.
- (I) To make local governance and govt. officials sensitive for convergence of poor with different govt. Schemes and programs.
- (m) Skill development of rural youth including female, adolescent and women members in environment friendly trades.
- (n) Livelihood promotion of poor, small and marginal framers.

#### **Working Strategy:**

To involve beneficiaries, community, youth, women groups and local governance in program planning, Implementation, monitoring and evaluation and making government machinery sensitive towards the issues of ultra poor.

#### **Target Group:**

Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Caste, Women, Children, Minorities, People with disability Adolescents, Young married youths & Old aged person, single women, widow, Disaster victim, migrate labor, leprosy-T.B. Patient etc.

Target Area: 07 districts, Patna, Jehanabad, Arwal, Supaul, Sahebgani, Ranchi, Nalanda etc.

#### Abhiyan initiatives :

#### **Initiatives at Jehanabad district**

Abhiyan is working with the objective of community based sustainable food security model at at 20 villages of Kako and Jehanabad blocks of Jehanabad district . 110 women members of 20 villages are imparted training on poultry and provided 10 chicks to each . Memebers are using eggs to eliminate malnutrition.

435 households are imparted training on kitchen garden and also provided seeds of different vegetables. Training is being imparted to households twice in a year. Households as well as locality are self dependent on vegetables for more than 6 months in a year, other households are also mobilised for vegetable production. Seed bank is also developed in the villages and now seeds are easily available for households. Villagers are also getting seeds of wheat and grams . 13 vermi compost has been developed at 13 villages , small and marginal farmers are using the vermin compost , it also facilitating other farmers for the practice of vermin compost.

Poor farmers are provided 14 boring facilities for timely irrigation and use of safe drinking water . Farmers are using this and improved agriculture production of farmers . Farmers are using different foods and malnutrition is diminishing in the area . But maximum farmers are landless and use other's land for the purpose of agriculture . Some of farmers are also working as agricultural labourers. ABHIYAN is working on education , training, food diversity , leadership development, environment conservation , vermin compost promotion , elimination of child labour and child marriage and convergence with govt. schemes and programs .

**Child protection committee-** child protection committee has been developed at ward level at 20 wards. Meeting happen in every 2 months, anganwari sewika, teachers, panchayat representatives, children representatives, adolescent girls, organization representatives participate in the meeting.

ABhiyan is taking regular efforts for true implementation of National food security scheme 2013 i.e. mid day meal, regular distribution at anganwari centres, regular food distribution through PDS, support in implementation of Prime Minister Wandana Yojna and enrolment at anganwari centres and schools. Also making effort for bringing PDS centres nearer, addition of villagers name in ration card as most of villagers don't have name in ration card. Also making effort for opening of individual bank account. Schools are lacking science and computer teachers in the ration of children, lacking computer facilities, fans, toilet facilities at schools, panchayat level committee is not functional. Abhiyan is making initiatives in this direction. Now there is improvement in status. There is regular monthly meetings of women, youth, adolescent girls and child groups. Panchayat committee is initiating for proper implementation of groups. 152 women have become farmers first time who were initially labourer. 22 have become panchayat representatives and 01 is Mukhiya.

Children Performance monitoring: for identification of malnutrition status monitoring is being done for 6 months to 5 years children. Following are the indicator for monitoring in status, development of body increase, loose muscles, not increase in height and weight as per age. Malnutrition is the prime reason of children death. Proper and regular test is important for minimising mal nutrition cases. Less weight of baby during child birth, problem in breast feeding, cough etc. are the inidicator to monitor the malnutrition. Total Mushar household at Mokar, Sewanan, Dharampur, Kalpa Khurd, Kalpa Kala, Gulzarbagh, Muther, Godiha, Sikaria, Bhagwanpur villages, Jehanabad block is 1014. 0-5 years children number is 878, presence during status monitoring 689. Rest children were out of villages. Total no. of mushar children at 10 villages Kako Mushari, Chotki Kako, Firoji, Salempur, Koshiyawan, Latan patti, ratanbigha, pali villages is 1333. Presence of boy 382 and 415 girls, total children 787 during status monitoring

#### Result of children status monitoring:

31% children are found malnourished and 16% children are found most malnourished. Parents are provided following suggestions, timely providing nutritious food to children, food providing in every 2 hours, timely immunization, providing iron tablet, sending children at NRC in case of high malnourished, use of green vegetables, mothers breast feeding,, periodic health check up, food diversification and providing to children. By such efforts children can be out of malnourishment.

#### Painting and speech competition during Women day:

On 6<sup>th</sup> March 2022 ABHIYAN and Viswa YUVAK KENDRA celeberated women day at salempur village of Kako block .Organized speech and painting competition for adolescent girls and youth under the leadership of Simran Raj , Mukhia. Chandrabhusan , Gayatri Kumari, Anmol Kumar, Shailendra Kumar, Tileshwar Kumar also participated in this program. 26 yoth and 53 adolescent girls participated in this program , speech and painting , their subject were bio-diversity , water conservation and sanitation women empowerment . Chandrabhusan detailed on women participation in Panchayati Raj, education , health, food security etc. Rita Kumari get 1<sup>st</sup> prize , Sunita Kumari 2<sup>nd</sup> prize and Kanchan Kumari 3<sup>rd</sup> prize . Organization felt that there are lots potential at dalit community , require their participation .

At sikaria village, jehanabad women conducted meeting with the objective of women leadership, education, health, employment. Bidyamati Devi presided the meeting. Also, Rita Devi, Sharda Devi, Babita Devi, Sunita Devi, Mohni Devi expressed their view on women empowerment.

Social Audit program: On June 2023 Abhiyan conduct social audit work at Titaibigha, Sikaria, Firoji and Salimpur. During the program Panchayat Mukhia, Zila Parisad member, Pramukh, Panchayat representatives, Anganwari Sewika, PDS holder, teachers heard the problemes and grivances of community people. Abhiyan reviewed the household survey and working for resolution. Survey conducted at 487 households of 4 villages, reviewd the status of food security and status monitoring of children. Community people raised following demands: timely opening of PDS centre, construction of Anganwari Centres, electricity facility at schools and anganwari centres, 200 daus jobs through MGNREGA, 3 dismil land to dalit families after 3 months of submission of application form, enrolment of name in Ration card after 1 month of submission of application, provision of regular preparation of new ration card, free provision of oil, soyabin, gram, dal at PDS centres, primary school at every village, 04 middle school at every panchayat, high school, technical college at block level, waste management facility at village, camp for preparation of new aadhar card, voter ID card, bank account opening, toilet facility at each household, information on different govt. schemes and programs through camp. Also community

demanded for free distribution of vegetable seeds for formation of kitchen garden, pacca road at dalit tola, training to farmers on vermin compost and provision of bhudan land to farmers.

**Formation of Child protection committee**: Abhiyan has formed child protection committee at ward level with the support of CCHT at 102 panchayats in Patna and Jehanabad districts. Issue covered are children violence, child marriage, child labour, children atrocity etc. During COVID-19, lots poor people lost their employment and children left school and engaged in work. It has increased the possibility of child trafficking, child protection committee at panchayat level is covering the issues.

#### Sagen Sakam program

ABHIYAN is working for Adivashi children education and their overall development at 20 Adivashi villages of Mandro block, Sahebganj district, Jharkhand. Due to COVID-19 schools and Anganwar Centres remain closed for a long time. Due to this not much work has been done at schools and Anganwari Centres in this year.

#### Campaign against child labour

The organization has run campaign against child labour, child marriage, dowry etc. 52 villages of Jehanabad districts. Community people are sensitized and made appeal for not engaging children at work and sending them for Anganwari Centres and Schools for education.

The Organization has sensitized community stakeholders, parents, women groups, youth and children on ill effects of child labour, child marriage and dowry. The Organization has developed youth, PRI members, women groups, community stakeholders as resources and responsible to take the responsibility and eliminate these social evils. At women group the issues are incorporated and regular advocacy has been made at village, panchayat, block and district level on the issues.

#### Campaign against human and child trafficking

ABHIYAN conducted campaign against human and child trafficking at 23 blocks of Patna districts. Made appeal to community people for elimination of human and child trafficking, which is a hinous form of crime. In the human and child trafficking campaign included youth, community stakeholders, women leaders, CBO members, PRI representatives who also participated in community mobilization and sensitization. The community people took oath of controlling such illegal work and informing such activities to administration. 77 girls are promoted for higher education after closing the plan of marriage.

#### **Right to information**

The Organization provided orientation on "Right to Information" to community people of 82 villages from Patna, Gaya, Jehanabad, Bhojpur, Nalanda, Sahebganj districts. Community people are provided form of right to information. Also sensitized on filling of form/documents necessary for getting information, authentic place/office for RTI. Further, there was detail discussion on technical aspects of RTI by the senior level resource persons, which increased information and knowledge of participants on RTI.

#### **Global warming**

The organization is continuously making community awareness on environment conservation and global warming. In this year awareness done among 628 farmers of 22 villages and 1116 children of 16 schools of Patna district. Farmers are mobilized of 18 villages of Jehanabad districts. As a result there is practice of plantation, saving of existing plants, less use of crackers, minimum pollution, promotion of use of natural manure, limited use of chemical fartilizers, plantation of fruit plant and tulsi plant at every household. Also developed community resource persons who are continuously making community sensitization on global warming issues.

**Life Training Program**: Abhiyan is implementing life training program at 9 tola of Kako block, Jehanabad. Community people are oriented and facilitated for food security and peace, also making efforts for building conducive environment. 1369 dalit households are benefitted from the program. Conducted survey of 600 households under Kowokalector survey. Organization is strengthening 16 Abhiyan Mahila Samuh. Goups are conducting regular meeting. Also formed 16 Abhiyan Bal Samuh including 346 children.

#### **COMPUTER TRAINING PROGRAM**

ABHIYAN is implementing computer literacy training program for literate unemployed poor including female at Sandalpur and Mashaurhi Patna. In the computer training program 26 female and 32 male youth are receiving computer training. Included poor and dalit female youth in computer skill training and their sustainable employment through timely jobs placement. The training was focused on training on Microsoft Office by eminent resource persons. Conducted ToT of the trainer before conduction of training.
