ANNUAL REPORT ABHIYAN FOR THE YEAR 2017-18

<u>The Origin</u>

Inspired with Gandhi Jee, Vinoba Bhave, Lohia and Lok Nayak Jai Prakash Naryan a group of people with improved social devotion and feeling organized themselves and formed a voluntary Organization with aim "To establish a just Society in which no one remain hungry, unemployed, illiterate and exploited." ABHIYAN came into existence on the eve of International Women's Day in 1991 and got registered under societies Registration Act, 21, 1860.

The key focus of the Organization is on upgrading status of vulnerable, ultra poor and challenged community people through mobilizing , sensitization, training , convergence with govt. schemes and making beneficiaries, different stakeholders and govt. officials sensitive towards grass root issues , COVID-19 awareness program and immunization . Further in the principle of homogeneity and philanthropic ideology, effort is to educate, organize, sensitize, empower and mainstreaming disadvantage section of the community. It has strong believe on participatory approach and blending of professionalism with social feeling.

Objective:

- (a) Campaigning against poverty, inequality, exploitation, injustice and ignorance.
- (b) Empowerment of the rural villagers through formation and strengthening of Selfhelp groups, livelihood promotion and encouraging scientific agricultural practices.
- (c) To create awareness and organize rural poor towards their rights, entitlement, duties and responsibilities by providing information and sensitization.
- (d) To mainstream disadvantage and challenged children with education and ensure reach of benefits and rights.
- (e) To improve water, sanitation and health status at rural villages through convergence with concerned govt. department, awareness and support in COVID-19.
- (f) Improving health and reproductive health status of mother, children and adolescent girls at the rural villages.
- (g) To strengthen local self-governance particularly to elected women representatives through sensitizing capacity building, improving decision making ability and developing leadership skill.

- (h) Rehabilitation of persons with disabilities in the communities and convergence with govt. schemes and programs.
- (i) Socio-economic and cultural empowerment of rural poor women.
- (j) Rehabilitation, capacity building for preparedness and support to flood victims.
- (k) Community sensitization towards environment conservation.
- (I) To make local governance and govt. officials sensitive for convergence of poor with different govt. Schemes and programs.
- (m) Skill development of rural youth including female, adolescent and women members in environment friendly trades.
- (n) Livelihood promotion of poor, small and marginal framers.



GLIMPSE OF ABHIYAN INITIATIVES AND ACHIEVEMENT IN 2020-21

1. Collective management of malnutrition and food insecurity

The Organization has mobilized and made aware community people of Kako and Jehanabad blocks , Jehanabad district including 20 villages on right to food, how to get out of malnutrition, govt. food security program, community networking with Panchayat Raj Institution and govt. departments, health and nutrition, training to legal committees, formation and strengthening of women , children , youth and adolescent girls community based organization . Also oriented and trained these community based organizations on their roles and responsibilities, kitchen garden, seed bank, water and sanitation etc. It has developed enthusiasm , awareness and they are in the way of self sustenance.

2. Convergence with govt. schemes and programs

At Jehanabad and Patna district the organization mobilized and sensitized poorest of the poor households on govt. schemes and program . Further, made networking and liaison with concerned govt. departments and govt. officials . Organize sensitization and linkage camps and did regular follow up with concerned govt. departments and assisted in convergence of eligible poorest of poor households . The progress in convergence with govt. schemes is as follows :

Preparation of new Adhar Card : 170, Preparation of MGNREGA JOB Card : 203, Providing Job under MGNREGA : 198, Pradhanmantri Matritva Vandana: 73, Preparation of Voter I Card : 23, Pradhanmantri Awas Yojna : 77, Rastion Card preparation : 247, Old Age Pension : 08, Repairing of hand pump : 13, Govt. support to migrant labour (Rs. 1000/- each) : 25, Free ration to migrant labour : 49, Janani Suraksha Yojna : 24, Jan dhan Yojna (support of Rs.500/- to each): 31, Kanya Uthan Yojna : 05, Seed distribution for Kitchen garden : 365.

3. Life culture and education program:

ABHIYAN is implementing life culture and education program among Mushar community at 10 villages of Masaurhi block, Patna. Children are being provided education on human values, labour contribution, play, skill, sanitation etc. along with formal education. In this year 218 children from 10 villages are benefitted from this program.

4. Sagen Sakam program

ABHIYAN is working for Adivashi children education and their overall development at 20 Adivashi villages of Mandro block, Sahebganj district, Jharkhand. Due to COVID-19 schools and Anganwar Centres remain closed for a long time. Due to this not much work has been done at schools and Anganwari Centres in this year.

5. Campaign against child labour

The organization has run campaign against child labour, child marriage, dowry etc. 52 villages of Jehanabad districts. Community people are sensitized and made appeal for not engaging children at work and sending them for Anganwari Centres and Schools for education.

The Organization has sensitized community stakeholders, parents, women groups, youth and children on ill effects of child labour, child marriage and dowry. The Organization has developed youth, PRI members, women groups, community stakeholders as resources and responsible to take the responsibility and eliminate these social evils. At women group the issues are incorporated and regular advocacy has been made at village, panchayat, block and district level on the issues.

6. Campaign against human and child trafficking

ABHIYAN conducted campaign against human and child trafficking at 23 blocks of Patna districts. Made appeal to community people for elimination of human and child trafficking , which is a hinous form of crime. In the human and child trafficking campaign included youth,

community stakeholders, women leaders, CBO members, PRI representatives who also participated in community mobilization and sensitization. The community people took oath of controlling such illegal work and informing such activities to administration. 77 girls are promoted for higher education after closing the plan of marriage.

7. Right to information

The Organization provided orientation on "Right to Information " to community people , stakeholders at Patna, Gaya, Jehanabad, Bhojpur, Nalanda, Sahebganj districts including 82 villages through organizing workshop. 2835 participants including community stakeholders, youth, women leaders , adolescents, PRI representatives etc. are provided orientation on " Right To Information " including process of getting information, filling of form/documents necessary for getting information, authentic place/office for RTI. Further, there was detail discussion on technical aspects of RTI by the senior level resource persons , which increased information and knowledge of participants on RTI. Further made action plan to strengthen the efforts and the Organization is also making advocacy at panchayat, block, district and state level.

8. Global warming

The organization is continuously making community awareness on environment conservation and global warming . In this year awareness done among 128 farmers of 12 villages and 116 children of 16 Schools at Patna district and among farmers of 18 villages of Jehanabad districts. As a result there is practice of plantation, saving of existing plants, less use of crackers , minimum pollution, promotion of use of natural manure, limited use of chemical fartilizers, plantation of fruit plant and tulsi plant at every household . Also developed community resource persons who are continuously making community sensitization on global warming issues.

9. Rehabilitation of disable persons

ABHIYAN has conduction disabled program at 10 villages of Patna district. Under this program identified disabled persons , helped them in preparation of disabled certificates and formation of disabled groups . Formed disabled group of 82 disabled persons and named as "Bihar Viklang Adhikar Abhiyan ". For the purpose made coordination with govt.

block offices and administration at block and district level. For successful of the program developed community volunteers, who are supporting the community in day to day basis and making effective liaison and coordination with administration and block and district officials.

10. Right to food program (TDH) :

ABHIYAN is continuously making efforts towards ensuring food security and development of environment conducive to peace and non violence at the project area of 9 hamlets of Kako block, Jehanabad District. There are 1369 target beneficiaries including dalit and mahadalit families. In this year detail survey under covocollector application has been done for 600 households . Formed 16 " ABHIYAN Mahila Samuh" and their strengthening process is continue. Groups are performing regular saving, credit and bank linkages. Also formed 16 "ABHIYAN Bal Samuh" including 346 children as member, 16 "ABHIYAN Kishori Samuh" including 209 members and 16 "ABHIYAN Yuva Samuh" including 226 members. The groups are being strengthened through monthly orientation cum sensitization meetings. 365 small and marginal farmers are distributed seeds for Kitchen garden . All the households have practiced kitchen garden and getting fresh vegetables by own. It has improved family members health and nutrition status. 19 poorest of the poor families have been supported for self employment.

11. COVID Awareness program :

COVID-19 infection badly effected urban as well as rural area in Bihar . Due to COVID-19 pandemic there was lock down for a long period to minimize the COVID-19 infection . It adversely effected the poor and they went to starvation . In such circumstances ABHIYAN COVID-19 awareness program at 4 slums of Patna, 28 villages of Jehanabad, 22 villages of Gaya, 8 villages of Sahebganj district. ABHIYAN conducted community awareness I,e, regular use of mask, social distancing , hand washing using sanitizer etc, mask distribution (198 households), distribution of fooding items (526 households), mobilization for COVID vaccination . Awareness focused on : Maintaining social/ physical distancing , hand washing by soap/sanitizer before and after the trainings, use of face-cover/ mask by every person , Ensuring members with more than 50 years age, sick members and members having children of less than 5 years, pregnant women, are at home . Further 1 unit vermin compost pit has been developed at the area, where a lots small and marginal farmers are getting benefitted . It is towards promotion of natural manure in the agriculture practice.

12. Education Program :

Siksha Sandesh :The Siksha Sandesh program is being implemented at 18 villages of Kako block, Jehanabad district. The poor children are provided quality education, awareness on health and sanitation, conducted play competition etc. 386 poor children are benefitted from this program. Conducted regular contact with the parents for regular attendance of the children at school. Also get the support of PRI members for ensuring quality education to poor children . It has developed enthusiasm and interest among the children towards education. Now developed habit of regular attendance at school among children.

This year, 403 children are enrolled in the school, including 163 from the Mushar community. 136 non school going children are also enrolled at school. A total of 7897 children are enrolled in the 38 schools selected by the campaign under the Shiksha Sandesh Project. A total of 221 teachers are employed in the said schools. Under Shiksha Sandesh project, 426 Musahar community children are enrolled in different schools from class 01 to 8, who are getting benefit of the project. Career guidance work is also being done in 13 high schools of Kako block under Shiksha Sandesh Project. The project is being implemented to address various problems faced by the target community in the field of education and nutrition so that people living in rural areas, children and the disabled can benefit more and more from the government schemes and become academically strong. The project staffs continued contact with the target community.

13. COMPUTER TRAINING CENTRE

ABHIYAN is implementing computer literacy training program for literate unemployed poor including female at Sandalpur and Mashaurhi Patna. In the computer training program 26 female and 32 male youth are receiving computer training . Included poor and dalit female youth in computer skill training and their sustainable employment through timely jobs placement . The training was focused on training on Microsoft Office by eminent resource persons . Conducted ToT of the trainer before conduction of training .

14. People's Organization

We have firm faith in the united strength of the community in claiming the respected place in the society. Committees have been formed at village level at Patna and Jehanabad districts which is the manifestation of people's power. The main objective of these committees are to identify those needs by mobilizing resources available at different levels. These committees also protest against the non implementation of govt. programmes and several form of exploitations. The committee people also sensitizing community on precautions need for COVID-19 pandemic i.e. use of mask, social distancing and hand sanitization.

15. Health , Sanitation and COVID awareness Program -

In this year ABHIYAN organized workshop on health , sanitation and COVID awareness including youth , adolescent, village heads, PRI members, teachers in 75 numbers. In the workshop made discussion on the importance of household as well as community sanitation. People are sensitized for the construction and use of toilet to avoid infections and water born diseases and practice safety measures of COVID-19. Female are made aware on personal hygiene after defecation and during bath, COVID protocols. It is important as women and children are vulnerable to water born diseases . Sensitized for hygienic practice during cooking, drinking water and feeding children. Emphasized for waste management at house and community. Asked to manage water logging during rainy season. People are benefited a lot from the workshop.

16. International Women's Day :-

As usual celebrated "women day" on 8th March 2021 at Mashaurhi Patna . During the program sensitized community people on women right issues. Organized rally and women members are sensitized through slogans, songs and distributing parcha. The rally ultimately converted into meeting . About 100 rural women participated in the program and followed COVID-19 protocol during the program. Also Discussed in details about different laws enacted to safe guard the interest and right of women followings provisioned i.e. Women Police Station, Women Commission, Women Help Line. It has improved the participants knowledge level, awareness and sensitivity.
